Bridging AZ Furniture Bank, Mesa: Purchase and deliver 120 beds to low-income families.

Chandler Christian Community Center: \$5,000 for hunger-relief and housing assistance to help families living in poverty overcome a crisis period.

Childsplay, Tempe: \$10,000 for the school touring program that takes theater experiences into schools across the state.

Crisis Nursery, Mesa: \$85,000 to help fund shelter and comprehensive child services to children at risk for abuse, neglect or abandonment or whose families are in crisis.

East Valley Adult Resources, Mesa: \$30,000 to help support the Meals on Wheels program.

Friends of Public Radio Arizona, Tempe: \$7,500 to support after-school programming in audio, video and digital media.

ICAN, Chandler: \$5,000 to help provide disadvantaged families with year-round out-of-school programs, transportation and some food.

Junior Achievement of Arizona, Tempe: \$10,000 to support financial literacy and workforce readiness education.

Maricopa Community Colleges Foundation, Tempe: \$77,500 to provide scholarships to high schoolers enrolled in the Achieving a College Education program. Also to support a journalism and communications scholarship.

Mesa United Way: \$10,000 to buy birthday gifts for 1,000 foster and kinship children through Helen's Hope Chest.

Metropolitan Youth Symphony, Mesa: \$5,000 to help more students participate in summer education programs at no charge.

Neighbors Who Care, Sun Lakes: \$5,000 to train volunteers who help provide services for

an aging population in the area.

Oakwood Creative Care, Mesa: \$5,000 to provide programs not covered by traditional sources, including music, art, pet therapy and yoga.

Si Se Puede Foundation, Chandler: \$5,000 to expand a robotics program for high schoolers.

Sun Sounds Foundation Inc., Tempe: \$5,000 to deliver free audio of current print publications to Arizonans who cannot read print due to a disability via radio, internet and phone.

Tempe Community Action Agency: \$15,000 to support a home-delivered meals program.

Treasures 4 Teachers, Tempe: \$5,000 to help alleviate the burden on teacher who have to buy their own classroom supplies.

United Food Bank, Mesa: \$40,000 to help alleviate hunger for low-income families in eastern Maricopa, Pinal, Gila and southern Navajo and Apache counties.

A New Leaf, Mesa: \$50,000 to provide safety and support for domestic-violence survivors and their children.

Against Abuse, Casa Grande: \$5,000 for emergency financial support for victims of domestic violence.
